Tabakobon (smoking necessaire), end of 19th century

Lacquered wood (Japanese cypress wood), silver

Kyokuroku (foldable chair), second half of 17th century

Wood (Japanese cypress wood), gold, silver, golden copper, decorated Japanese deerskin, silk, silk brocade, lacquer

Armor with bust in plates covered with dark red lacquered leather, end of 18th–beginning of 19th century

Steel, Japanese deerskin, lacquer, wood (Japanese foxglove tree), horsehair, silk, silk brocade

Do-maru armor with dark blue silk laces kebiki-style, mid-18th-century

Steel, copper alloy shakodu, golden and patinated copper, brass, Asian water buffalo horn, lacquer, silk, silk brocade

Composite armor with bust in two parts and laced in red silk, second quarter of the 16th century and first half of the 18th century

Steel, copper alloy, silver, gilded copper, ivory, Asian water buffalo horn, wood (Japanese foxglove tree), silk, lacquer, silk brocade

Composite armor with leather lacing and bust in two parts, mid-17th-century

Steel, lacquer, gold, Asian water buffalo horn, Asian black bear hairs, Japanese deerskin, silk, silk brocade

Helmet, first half of the 17th century

Steel, wood (Japanese foxglove tree), papier-mâché, lacquer, Japanese deerskin, horsehair, silk

Helmet, first half of the 17th century

Steel, gilded copper, lacquer, gold, Japanese foxglove tree, silk, Japanese deerskin

Kura (Saddle), 17th century

Oak wood, lacquer, Japanese abalone mother-of-pearl, gold, hemp, silk

Katana, end of 16th–beginning of 17th century

Red oak wood, Japanese boxwood, rosewood, ebony wood, ivory (Asian elephant), Asian water buffalo horn, Japanese black tortoise, malachite, Japanese abalone mother-of-pearl

Tsuba (sword hilt): 8.5 x 7.5 x 0.5 centimeters
